Maximum Monthly Benefit*

Surviving Spouse	\$1,558
Single Veteran	\$2,424
Married Veteran	\$2,874
Two Vets Married	\$3,845

These maximum annual pension rates (MAPR) are based on a 2.8% COLA** and are subject to income, unreimbursed medical expense deductions, and a net worth limit of \$163,699. For official, up-to-date information, visit VA.gov.

***Actual benefit amount is determined by the VA based on eligibility. Amounts may increase each year.**

****COLA is cost of living adjustment**

Did you know that many wartime veterans and their spouses may qualify for extra monthly income from the Department of Veterans Affairs?

These benefits are known as the VA Aid and Attendance Pension. Benefits are based on a sliding scale and can be applied to the cost of at-home or community-based assisted or supportive living services.
