My career began when I was still in High School. One day a Hollywood agent stopped me as I was crossing the road and signed me on a 7 year contract without a screen test! I was 17 years old.



I began my career in 1958 making cameo appearances in the *Donna Reed Show*, *Dynasty, and Columbo*.


My first lead role was in *Crime & Punishment U.S.A.* (1959) followed by *Home on the Hill* (1960).
